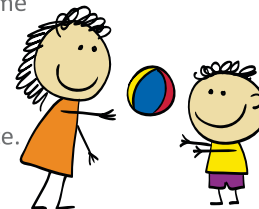
## Why choose us?

- ⑥ Educators are located throughout your area, providing both part-time and full-time care, allowing you to choose an Educator who best meets you and your child's needs.
- ⑥ Receive daily information regarding your child's education and care.
- ⑥ Our qualified, experienced Early Childhood teachers regularly visit your child in your Educator's home and at our various groups.
- ⑥ Receive regular contact from your Visiting Teacher who will work alongside you and your Educator to meet your aspirations for your child.
- ⑥ Alternative care is available for your child if your Educator is unavailable.



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- ⑥ Educators provide an educational programme incorporating the Early Childhood Curriculum, Te Whāriki.

- ② Up to 20 hours free per week for all three and four year olds.
- ③ Great rates and access to WINZ and ELP subsidies.
- ④ Educators have free access to our educational toy library.
- ⑤ Educators have free access to nursery equipment.
- ⑥ Educators have access to free playgroups and excursions.
- ⑦ A digital camera is provided to each Educator so that they can document your child's care and education.
